OUTLINE FOR INVENTORY SYSTEM

1. A complete inventory of all stock on premises to be taken at periodic intervals. An account of stock received to be made available to be posted on inventory sheets.
2. Designated keys on register to be assigned for explicit items, examples: A - Liquor, B- Beer, C- Food, and etc., miscellaneous. Overings to be initialed by person making them and re-rung properly.
3. Register tapes, shifts and dates to be initialed by personnel on duty. Said personnel to be held responsible for any and all discrepancies that may arise on any specific shift. Should this occur and continue to reoccur, could lead to the dismissal of persons responsible.
4. Register tapes to be available to inventory crew, bar Charman and Finance officer to be coordinated at periodic intervals.
5. Specific money making projects shall be the Sole Responsibility of the chairman in charge of said function..
- 6.. Volunteer personnel have the privelege of one free drink after his or her shift has ended. Salaried personnel excluded. In other words - No Freebies!!!
7. REITERATE - personnel on duty to be held **SOLELY RESPONSIBLE !!**.
