Commander, April 2014 report

1. On April 3rd , I presided over the E-Board and General Membership meetings.
2. On April 4th , I mailed out the By-Laws revisions to Department for approval. I later received a verbal notification from Dept. Judge Advocate Larry Sheets regarding Article V Section 2. *This section reads (50) days and needs to be changed to (90) days and we also needed to add the following: newly elected Post Officers shall not enter upon their duties until they are installed by the District Commander or his/her representative within sixty (60) days after the adjournment of the Department Convention.* These technical corrections were made and resubmitted for approval.
3. On April 7th , along with Dan Wortmann, Mike Barker, Tex Ward, and Robert Scarlett removed the old carpet and padding from the Post floor.
4. On April 8th , Pete Braud and Gary Amonette of Braud Design & Build began renovations to the Post floor and later the ceiling beam on the north side of the hall.

6. On April 16th , I helped Steve Sheffield power grind the high spots on the floor near the pool table, at the transition from concrete to wood floor.
7. On April 17th , I presided over the K9s for Warriors graduation ceremony.
8. On April 21st , I attended the House Committee meeting.
9. On April 27th , I attended the 5th District Constitutional Conference at Post 316 Atlantic Beach. Here I was elected as a delegate to the National Convention to be held in Charlotte, NC in August 2014.
10. On April 28th , along with Don Mills, Jim Durnal, Mike Barker and Howard Sheble picked up the new carpet from storage on A1A. The old carpet in the meeting room was also removed.

11. On April 29th, Beaches Flooring & Decorating installed the new carpet in the main Post hall and meeting room. I also attended a budget meeting with the entity heads and/or treasurers, held by Finance Officer Tom Leppard.
12. During the month of April, I made 15 separate trips to the Post for the renovation project. I logged 89.5 hours of volunteer time and traveled 872 miles on Legion business.
