

August web activities resulted in 1,174 individual visitors, viewing 2,319 pages on the site.

The three most viewed pages this month were the 'August Newsletter', the 'Special Events' page and the 'Bulletins' page. The top slideshow viewed was the Installation of Officers on July 11<sup>th</sup> .

During the past 12 months there have been a total of 12,901 individual visitors who have viewed a total of 30,758 pages.

Current site disk usage is 320.7 MB out of the 300,000 MB allotted space for the site.

#### New webpage:

The military is producing more and more tech savvy veterans these days. In order for the local Posts of the American Legion to keep in contact with our current members and to enlist new members we must continue to advance our efforts not only on the internet but also on the many social networks provided. This past year alone, the National American Legion website has expanded a thousand fold, and many of the events, meetings and other functions have been video recorded and are available online. Over the past few years our website has expanded and become a virtual archive of information for the Post. We have also expanded our internet presence on Facebook. As webmaster, I would like to take our website a step further in the future by providing a live video stream of Legionnaire membership meetings, that not only will be able to be viewed in real time, but can be archived for future reference. I am not aware of any other Post that presently undertakes this task, and I would like to see Post 233 as a forerunner of this process.

I would ask that Post 233 Legionnaires complete the yes/no survey online. The results will be presented to the membership at a later date. If the survey results are positive, I would then motion that a committee be formed to set basic guidelines to be presented to the membership for approval.

Speaking of Facebook, I would like to thank Patty O'Callahan, Kathy Church and Diane Beason for their help in posting information and flyers, for upcoming events, to our Post 233 Facebook page. Great job, Ladies!

During the month of August, I logged a total of 27.50 hours of website related volunteer time for a grand total of 260.8 hours over the past year. About 10 hours of this time involved beta testing the video streaming process outlined above.
