Commander, February 2014 report

1. On February 4th , I had a meeting with Diane Dorsey and Rita Connolly at the Post.

Lastly, John Cheek of Beaches Flooring has quoted us a cost to install the carpet we currently have in storage at \$1.00 sq.ft. includes padding. These last two quotes will be discussed further at our next meeting.
7. On February 18th I filed the necessary paperwork with BBVA Compass Bank ,updating all Post accounts and signing their required forms.
8. On February 20th I presided over the K9s For Warriors graduation ceremony.
9. On February 24th I attended the House Committee meeting.
