Membership eligibility

The American Legion If you have served on federal active duty in a branch of the United States Armed Forces since December 7, 1941 and have been honorably discharged or you are still serving on active duty, you are eligible for membership.

American Legion Auxiliary

Membership is open to grandmothers, mothers, sisters, wives, and direct adopted female descendants of American Legion members and those who served in the U.S. Armed Forces during The American Legion eligibility periods. Eligible female veterans can be dual members. Our auxiliary unit works with the Legion on various programs.

Sons of The American Legion All male descendants, adopted sons and stepsons of members of The American Legion - and such male descendants of veterans who died in service in all wars, or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service, shall be eligible for membership.

American Legion Riders

Membership is open to all active members of The American Legion, The American Legion Auxiliary and Sons of The American Legion, including those on active federal duty in the U.S. Military. Members must own and ride motorcycles and be active members within The American Legion Family.
