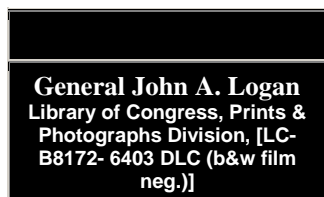

Below is the history of Memorial Day.



Memorial Day was officially proclaimed on 5 May 1868 by General John Logan, national commander of the Grand Army of the Republic, in his [General Order No. 11](#), and was first observed on 30 May 1868, when flowers were placed on the graves of Union and Confederate soldiers at Arlington National Cemetery. The first state to officially recognize the holiday was New York in 1873. By 1890 it was recognized by all of the northern states. The South refused to acknowledge the day, honoring their dead on separate days until after World War I (when the holiday changed from honoring just those who died fighting in the Civil War to honoring Americans who died fighting in any war). It is now celebrated in

almost every State on the last Monday in May (passed by Congress with the National Holiday Act of 1971 (P.L. 90 - 363).

In 1915, inspired by the poem "[In Flanders Fields](#)," Moina Michael replied with her own poem:

We cherish too, the Poppy red  
 That grows on fields where valor led,  
 It seems to signal to the skies  
 That blood of heroes never dies.

May is Poppy month and keeping with tradition the Auxiliary will be asking for donations for this program. Money donated for Poppies goes to rehabilitation for military members. The Auxiliary is still in need of a Poppy Chairman. Contact me if you would like to help out with this. We also need members to help out over Memorial Day weekend to collect donations in some public spots.

It is hard to believe this but it is once again time to start thinking about our 2012 Officers. Barbara Turley is heading up our Nominating Committee and will be publishing a notice regarding this. There are several positions that will be open including Auxiliary President and Secretary. If you are interested in any open position please let me know and I will pass it on to Barbara.

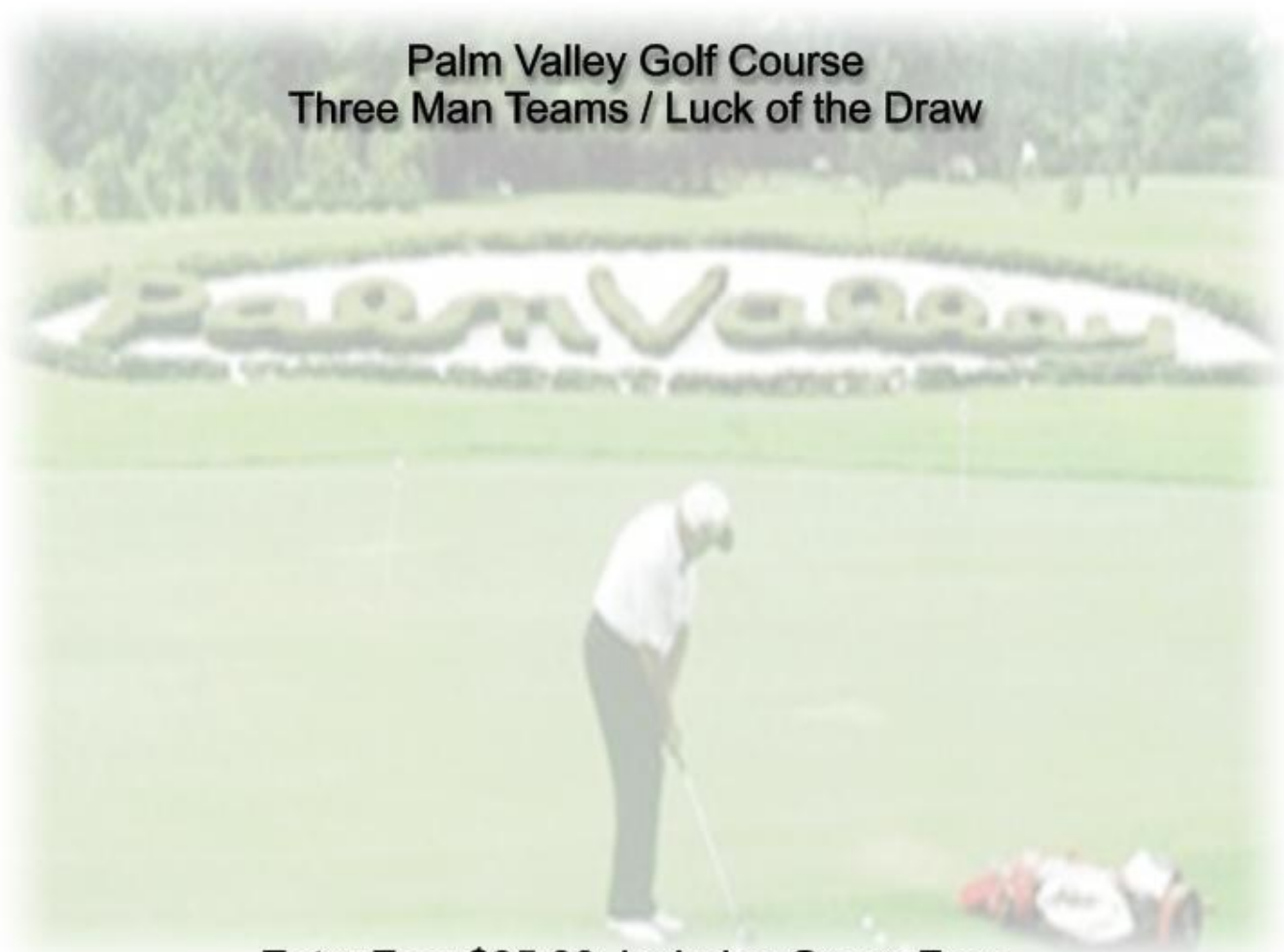

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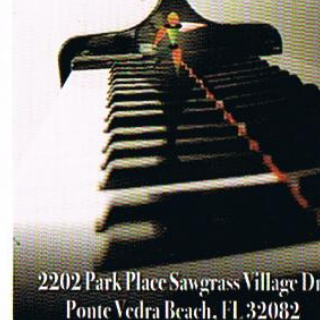

# BEACHES VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK

## HISTORY: ★★★★★★★★★★★★★★★★★★

The beach area has a long history with the military, particularly Naval Station Mayport. Many military men and women have chosen the area to retire in, and there are numerous veterans organizations located in the area. In 2006 the city of Atlantic Beach acquired land at the intersection of Mayport Road and Atlantic Blvd., and designated it as a Veterans Memorial Park.

In 2009 a "Community Covenant" was developed between most of the veteran service organizations and the beach cities for mutual support of veteran issues. Those veteran organizations formed an organization, the "Beaches Veterans Memorial Park, Inc." as a not-for-profit corporation and, through a formal agreement with the city of Atlantic Beach to complete the Park, agreed to make it into a fitting place to hold veteran ceremonies and serve the entire community.

## WHERE WE ARE NOW: ★★★★★★★★★★

Through grants and donations from local organizations, funding was obtained to start landscaping the Park and erect an 80' Flagpole which displays the national flag as a focal point when entering the beach area via Atlantic Blvd. Future plans include a stage area, a veterans memorial garden area with special recognition of all Chaplains who have made the ultimate sacrifice, more brick walkways, a children's improved play area, restrooms and additional parking.

**Additional funding is necessary** to complete the work. With the main entrance to the park a brick walkway, what more fitting way to raise funds than to sell engraved bricks which will forever memorialize you, or a Veteran relative or friend. Minimum donation is \$75/brick.

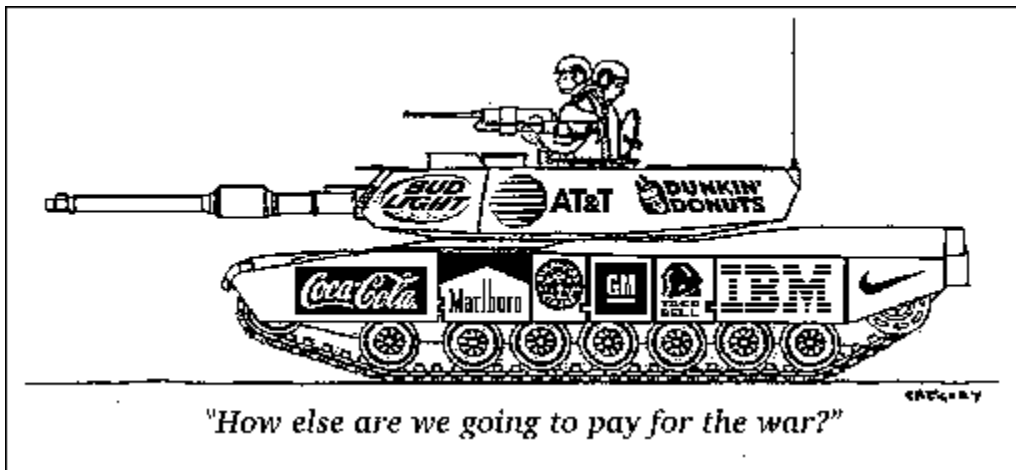
