Commander's Corner.

Hello Post 233 Family:

Membership! Membership! Membership! American Legion (National) will be raising dues January 1st by \$8.00 – please renew early and save \$8.00 for every year you pre-pay.

WOW! What a great month for our Post in July! Unfortunately, the 4th of July event was not what we wanted due to weather – but we still celebrated our Country's birthday in American Legion Post 233 style! On Friday, July 17th we served over 90 plates of food – the music by The Collage was spectacular and the volunteers were awesome! Special thanks to Chef Mike Shaar, Lynette, Betty, Caroline, Noah, JR, Jim, Debbie, Ellie, Paul and Wally.

Having said that, our Post has some major structural issues (i.e., electrical, aging septic sewer tank system and interior ceiling issues) just to mention a few that need attention. Some history: when the Post sold the property on Canal/Roscoe and purchased the existing property, they were "grandfathered" to allow the property to become "commercial" versus "residential." However, if the Post suffers a catastrophic event that requires us to pull a building permit, we could be facing crossroads of being disapproved and facing tough decisions. My initial thought process is to research our options:

(1) Have the property appraised.

- (2) New Building options, variances and permits required
- (3) Corporate sponsorship and donations

(4) Option of new location (sell the property) and look at Old Palm Valley Road, Nacottee, etc... and lease with working capital in the bank! Create a building fund and become more financially solvent.

(5) Stay where we are at and continue to put good money after bad!

This vision is just in its preliminary stages and I will compile a presentation that will provide all our options along with county officials that will support our decisions.

On July 20, 2015, President Obama signed P.L. 114-31 into law. This new law directs the Veterans Administration to issue new VA Identification cards

to all veterans. The intent of the new law appears to make it easier for a veteran to prove his veteran status without having to carry a copy of his DD214, as that document provides personal information such as social security numbers and would make identity theft easier if lost or stolen. As of this writing the Veterans Administration has yet to say how this new system will be implemented and what the fee for this new card will be. Hopefully the Veterans Administration will think hard and deep when they formalize the implementation process for this new Linda Williams Chaplain



Ladies and gentlemen, I would like to invite you to take a few moments and renew your Legion membership while the price is low. Yes, you heard correctly, the Annual Membership will increase by \$8.00 on 1 January 2016. So, why not renew now and save a few dollars. It is as easy as paying on line to American Legion National Headquarters at www.floridalegion.org, then "click" on RENEW in the center of the screen, then follow the instructions. After you complete this payment, National will notify me and I will forward you your 2016 membership card. The next easiest way would be to come to the Post Monday-Friday form 1000hrs to 1700hrs and pay be directly and receive your 2016 membership card. If you choose, you can come by the Post any day Monday – Sunday and give the bartender on duty an envelope with your payment (\$35.00) in it and your name on the envelope. The bartender will place the envelope in my box and I will have your card at the bar waiting for you within two business days. If you desire, you can indicate on the envelope that you would like for me to mail you your card and I will be glad to do it. You can also choose to mail your payment to the Post and I will receive it and then have your card ready for pickup at the bar within two business days.

Also remember that if you pay your 2016 dues prior to 11 November you will be eligible to attend the "Early Bird" meal later this year. So, if you act not and pay your renewal dues before 11 November not only will you save \$8.00 but you will also receive a complementary meal. Why wait, act not while it is fresh on your mind.


