Hurricane Irma did a number on our Bingo Program. On September 7th, we had only 10 or 11 players so we played only two regular games and one coverall. We awarded \$200 that night. Despite the storm, in the last four weeks, we have awarded \$2450 to our players.

For those who wonder what the Bingo Program has brought to Post 233, through the end of August 2017, during the 8 months of this calendar year, our players who are members, neighbors and guests of Post 233 have received over \$19,000 in payouts and the Canteen income now exceeds over \$15,000 on Thursday nights. The Lucky Ball Pool has paid out \$596 with the current balance at \$259.

We are very pleased that on the third Thursday of each month, Kathy Church will provide a meal for the benefit of the MIA Program. The food has been excellent and well received by those in attendance. Come join us and help two programs at the same time.

Let's continue to build our Bingo Program so please participate, invite your friends and/or neighbors. We are open to the public for Bingo so no need for you to be present if you encourage others to participate. We have many winners each week including some new players.

Now on to the website at <u>www.AL233FL.org</u>. The most recent stats show that we are nearing 1 gigabyte of uploaded files of the 300 gigabyte of server space allocated for our domain. As of this writing, the viewer stats for July, August and September show we have had over 6,764 visitors who have viewed more than 13,741 pages of information. Our viewers are primarily viewing our newsletters, Legion meeting minutes, our Memorial pages and our e-calendar page. New to the website as of September 23rd, are the upload of the following Post minutes for the following years, 1971 to 1979, 1981 to 1983, Aug-Dec 2006 and Jan-Jun 2007. The first 7 months of 1971 are still missing at this time, but are very important to the history of our Post since this is the year we received our charter. These newly posted minutes can be accessed at http://www.al233fl.org/minutes.htm and scroll to the bottom of the page to select a year to view. I would note that these files were boxed and set to be discarded (to make more room in the office) before I was elected Post Commander. I retrieved them and have safeguarded them since. The only other files I have yet to be copied are the minutes from 1981 to 1983.

If any member, reading this newsletter, who has knowledge of the existence of meeting minutes and or notes/reports of the following years, please contact me at <u>roy@havekost.net</u>. I believe it is necessary to preserve our Post history as best we can for future generations to come. The missing years needed are: 1971 Jan to Jul, 1980 full year, 1987 to 2005 full years.

Once I have completed this project of minutes/records compilation, hopefully before The American Legion Centennial Celebration in 2019, I intend to transfer all of the data to DVD disk and make the same available to any member for a nominal donation to Post 233.

October 2017 Newsletter input, Judge Advocate Roy Havekost

Hello Legionnaires, I am including a short article in this newsletter to bring the membership up to date regarding Post by-laws. The Department of Florida recommends that every Post in the State update and submit a copy of their by-laws every three years. This doesn't mean that they can't be changed and resubmitted within those three years. When changes are made to by-laws and voted on by the general membership, they need to be forwarded to Department for approval. This process can sometimes take up to a couple of months. The membership cannot begin to follow their new by-law changes unless and until they are approved by Department.

Post 233's latest change/update took place at the June general meeting and was approved by Department on August 22, 2017. These by-laws can be viewed online on the Post website and a copy is on file in the Post Commanders Office for viewing.

One important change that was recommended by Department this year was that all Legion meetings, initiations and ceremonies will be held in accordance with The American Legion Post Officers Guide and any situations and circumstances not covered in this guide will no longer be referred to Roberts Rules of Order. For this reason Article XI of our by-laws has been modified to exclude Roberts Rules.

On another note, for the good of the Legion, nominations for 1st Vice Commander will be taken at the October 11th meeting due to the recent resignation of James Durnal. Nominations will also be taken for one vacant Executive Board member slot. Interested members should attend this general meeting.
