Much discussion about banking and BINGO compliance with IRS regulations; Post in compliance. PC Warwick stated, <b><i>"THAT WE WILL NOT TOUCH YOUR MONEY."</i></b> PC Warwick reported the start-up of the QUEEN OF HEARTS this Friday (July 25<sup>th</sup>). Payout percentages 10% money; 30% House, and 60% to the winner. PC Warwick addressed to potential charges for Post/bartender usage of \$30 to protect the Post from liabilities; approved to get Mike Sharr certified and become a non-compensated employee to protect the Post. VC2 Correia expressed personal sacrifices with spending over \$600 (of his own money) this past week on the Post. Post Finance Officer resigned; no replacement was nominated to date.</li><li>○ Finance Officer (FO) Kirkwood addressed the "balancing act" of being a SAL Officer along with Legion Judge Advocate to the Post Commander.
